

Integrated Impact Assessment Statement – 23/24 Savings Programme

2C Practices

2C Practices are GP practices which have been brought in-house and are managed by the EHSCP. The in-year Phase 1 savings proposal relates to grip and control measures focused on reducing the reliance on supplementary and locum staff. This is anticipated to deliver an in-year saving of £50,000. As this does not involve any changes to service models or policy and will have no detrimental impact on patients or staff, it is considered that an Integrated Impact Assessment is not required.

A further phase of work is planned which may deliver additional financial benefit within 24/25 and beyond. This will involve scoping the possibility of returning the practices to independent management. If this is not feasible, then options will be developed for increasing income streams through enhanced services – such as providing junior medical training within the practices. As plans are developed, any impacts will be identified and if required, a full IIA completed to inform next year's savings programme.

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
