Summary: Services available: browse and borrow books, return your books, pick up free period products, use the photocopier, collect hearing aid batteries, use a public computer and print, use a study space, apply for a National Entitlement Card (bus pass), borrow a musical instrument for free, just like a book! Many instruments are available e.g., guitar, violin, keyboard, clarinet, cello, trumpet.
